PRO SE APPLICANTS FOR OCCUPATIONAL DRIVERS LICENSE WITHOUT CONTESTED HEARING

If you are seeking an Occupational Driver's License and need assistance, the Wilson County Attorney's Office will review your petition and order prior to filing under the following circumstances:

- 1. You must bring the eligibility requirements from the DPS Driver's License webpage http://www.dps.texas.gov/driverlicense/ , the order suspending/revoking your driver's license, your 3 year driving record, a letter from your employer or proof of enrollment in an educational institution.
- 2. A Petition and Order can be obtained from <u>http://texaslawhelp.org/resource/occupational-</u> <u>drivers-license</u>
- 3. For additional requirements you may review the Texas Transportation Code at http://www.statutes.legis.state.tx.us/Docs/TN/htm/TN.521.htm
- 4. You may schedule an appointment to meet with the prosecutor at 830-393-7305.
