PROCLAMATION

THE STATE OF TEXAS §
COUNTY OF WILSON §

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT WHEREAS, on November 2, 2010, there was duly and legally held throughout Wilson County, Texas, an election for the purpose of enabling the voters to determine whether to allow horses, mules, jacks, jennets, donkeys, hogs, sheep, or goats to run at large.

WHEREAS, the undersigned County Judge of Wilson County, Texas, has tabulated and counted the returns and ascertained the results of said election in the manner required by law and has found that the majority of votes cast at such election were against allowing horses, mules, jacks, jennets, donkeys, hogs, sheep or goats to run at large.

WHEREAS, I, Marvin C. Quinney, County Judge of Wilson County, Texas, do hereby issue this as my Proclamation declaring that such election resulted in prohibiting horses, mules, jacks, jennets, donkeys, hogs, sheep, or goats from running at large throughout the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, I order and direct that this Proclamation shall be posted at the Courthouse of this County and there after the expiration of thirty days from its issuance, it shall be unlawful to permit horses, mules, jacks, jennets, donkeys, hogs, sheep or goats to run at large throughout Wilson County.
